Room Description

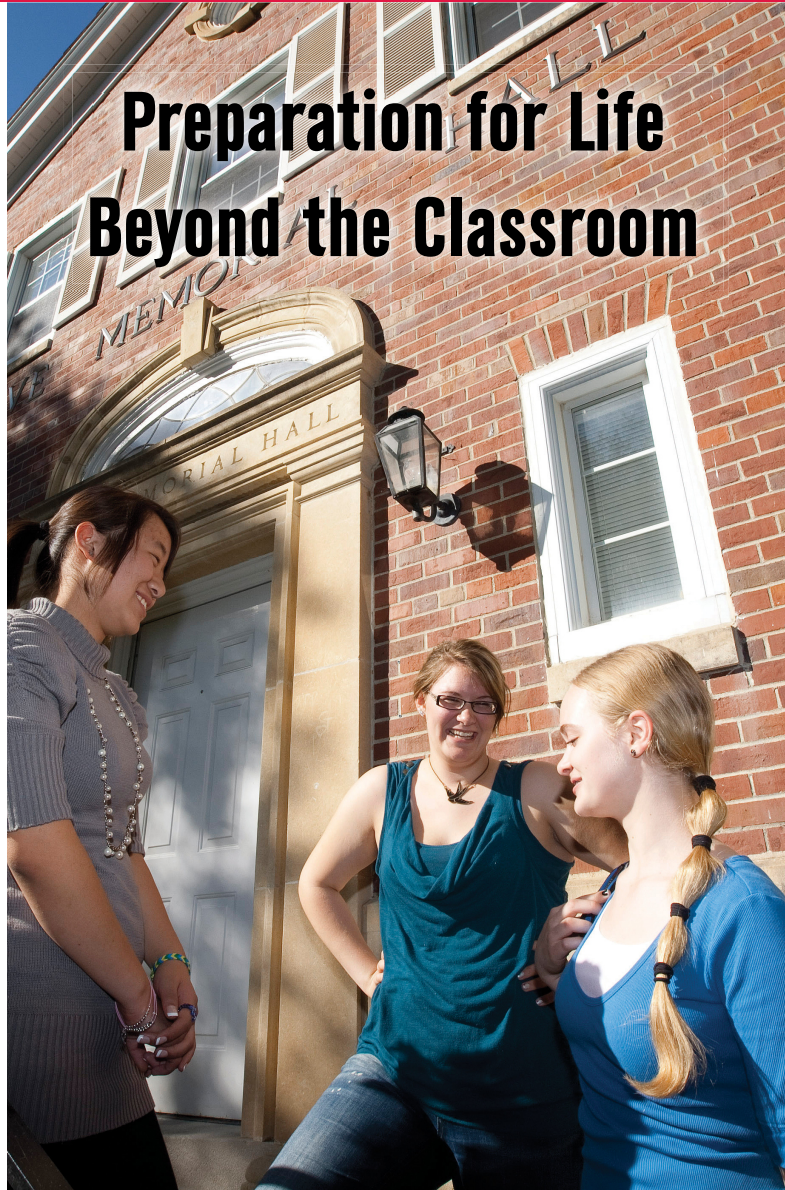
- Capacity of 42 residents

Love Memorial Hall

Love Memorial Hall is an all female housing option open to all current undergraduate students. Love Memorial Hall is an excellent option for those women looking for a less expensive, cooperative learning and living experience.

History

Love Memorial Hall began in 1940 when Donald L. Love, a former Lincoln mayor, donated \$45,000 in memory of his wife to build Love Memorial Hall. The hall's mission was to help young women enrolled in Home Economics make their way through college. Today the hall, still located on UNL's beautiful East Campus, is open to young women of all majors. Love Memorial has an active alumni association that participates in gatherings with current residents throughout the year. The association also offers scholarships and provides funds for hall improvement projects annually.

Responsibility

While learning in your classes you will also be gaining knowledge for life outside the classroom by living in Love Memorial Hall. Residents learn to balance homework with their Love Memorial Hall responsibilities of cooking and cleaning daily on rotation, approximately 4-6 hours per week. If the thought of all this overwhelms you, don't be concerned. Returning residents are more than willing to help with Love Memorial Hall responsibilities and any challenging class work. The Love Memorial Hall is a treasure trove of resources for any of your needs as a student a resident.

Leadership

One of the many benefits found at Love Memorial Hall is a sense of involvement that can't be replicated by a traditional residence hall. Whether a "Lovely" decides to become an officer or just be involved with committees, there is an opportunity for everyone to take on a leadership role. The hall carries on traditions from year to year such as hosting a Thanksgiving dinner and a spring formal dance which allow residents to work together and help plan events. To ensure every resident is involved, each resident is on two committees: **event committees** that plan events such as our formal or **year-long activity committee** that organize recycling or health and fitness, amongst others.

Friendship

Love Memorial Hall residents cherish the friendships developed while living in the hall. Love Memorial Hall houses approximately 42 beds. Residents become a very close knit family. The hall is usually referred to as more of a "home" than a residence hall. Student led activities such as movie nights, spa events, and even the nightly routine of cooking, create a bond between the residents that last a lifetime.

Cost

As mentioned, Love Memorial Hall is a cooperative learning and living experience. The all-female hall is less than half the cost of a traditional residence hall. In addition, all residents pay a food stipend.
